### **AMERICA WILL COME TOO LATE!**

- says German Propaganda

Overleaf you can read some of the most famous sayings of your leaders and propagandists. Most of them have already been proved false; it will not be long before the remainder are proved false too.

One of the favourite themes of German Propaganda is that American help will reach England too late. No one in Germany disputes that the U.S.A. are now determined to prevent a German victory by all means; no one in Germany disputes that the industrial and military potential of the U.S.A. – quite apart from that of Great Britain and the British Empire – is far greater than that of Germany together with all the occupied countries of Europe. But -so they tell you – America's help will come too late.

Here are a few facts. THEY REFER ONLY TO AIRCRAFT, not to tanks, ships, food and everything else which America has already delivered to England and her Allies and is now delivering in even greater quantities.

- 1) AMERICAN AIRCRAFT made touch with the Bismarck and brought the British Fleet into contact with her as she was trying to escape.
- 2) AMERICAN AIRCRAFT have flown many millions of miles in the protection of British convoys.
- 3) AMERICAN AIRCRAFT have made more than a hundred attacks on German U-boats and 211 attacks on German and Italian surface ships.
- 4) AMERICAN AIRCRAFT are taking part in the battle for Suez and have destroyed numerous German and Italian bombers and fighters in the Near East.
- 5) AMERICAN AIRCRAFT are operating every day from Norway to the Red Sea.
- 6) AMERICAN AIRCRAFT are amongst the best night fighters which defend Great Britain. Together with British night fighters they destroyed 108 night bombers in fourteen days in May.
- 7) AMERICAN AIRCRAFT regularly attack German aerodromes in France, Holland and Belgium.
- 8) AMERICAN WARPLANES, greater and with a longer range than any previous aircraft, are now flying with the R.A.F. Among these aircraft are long range machines such as the Havoc and Boston Fighters, the Buffalo and Tomahawk fighters, the Martlet Fighters which serve with the Fleet Air Arm, the Marylands and Catalina (reconnaissance flying boats) and the Boeing,

Liberator and Hudson Bombers. The names of other types may not yet be mentioned.

And now reflect: so far American aircraft form only a very small proportion of the R.A.F.! To be sure, American production is already big; but next year it will be much bigger. And British aircraft production too, is increasing. Here is one example; the new gigantic English bombers can lift a bomb load four or five times bigger than that carried by any type which has been in use up to now either on the German or on the English side.

And how will all this go on?
