To all those who took up weapons to oppose the government, and to those that participated in subversive organisations in the states of Sarawak and Sabah:

1. This is a SAFE CONDUCT PASS.
2. Bring this safe conduct pass out to report personally to the authorities.

To every member of the public:

1. Those that bear this safe conduct pass wish to come out and report personally to the authorities.
2. Please help the pass bearer to report to the authorities. By doing so you will receive a reward.

**SAFE CONDUCT PASS  
TO SECURITY TEAM MEMBERS**

The bearer of this Security Pass wants to report themselves to the authorities.

Please help them to report safely.

*(REVERSE)*

To all those who took up weapons to oppose the government, and to those that participated in subversive organisations in the states of Sarawak and Sabah:

1. Any combatants among you that truthfully intend to cease opposing the government will receive assistance to regain your freedom and to return home to reunite with family members.
2. You must personally report to any Security Forces personnel, Government officers, village heads, or members of the public.
3. If you have any firearms, carefully hide them before you report so that the government can retrieve them later. If you assist the government in retrieving your firearms, you will receive a reward.
4. If you and your family members wish to leave Malaysia, your request will be given consideration.
5. Members of the public that help you to cease resisting and come out to report to the authorities will receive a reward.
